- AJC Announces April 29 STICKER DAY & Campaign Launch -

For more than a year, Canada's federal lawyers have tried to convince the federal Government to give Canadians confidence that when Canada's interests are at stake – their legal representatives are the best.

The Association of Justice Counsel (AJC) representing 2,500 federal lawyers has made it clear: Treasury Board's words will ring hollow unless they back up their words with action. **You can only recruit and retain the best federal lawyers if you are committed to fair and reasonable compensation competitive and terms and conditions of employment with comparable positions in private practice and with provincial governments.**

This is not a difficult concept, yet it eludes Treasury Board decision makers time and time again.

That's why, on April 29, federal lawyers across Canada are going to deliver the message in person: ***Federal lawyers deserve justice!***

STICKER DAY: On Tuesday, April 29, to kick-off their new public relations campaign, federal lawyers in offices all over Canada will start wearing the AJC's new sticker proudly declaring: **"FEDERAL LAWYERS DESERVE JUSTICE!"**
