

## AJC Dues Holiday explained

2005-10-19 (revised 2006-03-27)

In return for member assistance to cover the costs of the certification process and other operating expenditures, the AJC is offering a dues holiday for an amount equivalent to 133% of the dues paid in 2004, 2005 and/or 2006 when the Rand Formula will be implemented.\*

For 2006 the AJC is asking for a contribution of \$100 from LAs at every level.\*\*

Initial cost for LA-2 and above	\$600	\$300	\$100
Tax deduction	\$300	\$150	\$50
Dues holiday	\$800	\$400	\$133

\* If you paid dues in both 2004, 2005 and 2006, the amounts are cumulative.
